Food for bus trips:

- Snack food items such as granola bars, protein bars, dried fruit, nuts, trail mix (non-melting ingredients)
- Cereal cups
- Crackers
- Bottled water
- Gatorade
- Pedialyte (not clear variety)
- Juice pouches
- Peanut butter and jelly
- Sliced bread
- Applesauce (cups or pouches)
- Fresh fruits (mandarins, apples, bananas and grapes)

Toiletry items:

- Toothpaste (travel size) and toothbrushes (for kids, too)
- Hair combs/brushes, Hair ties/bands, Hair gel
- Deodorant (travel-sized)
- Chapstick/lip balm
- Nail clippers
- Kleenex packets
- Lotion
- Body bar soap
- Razors and shaving cream
- Travel shampoo and conditioner
- Wash cloths

Baby/Child care items:

- Baby formula (powdered or liquid) in travel sizes
- Diaper wipes

Miscellaneous items:

- Shoe laces
- Backpacks
- Travel blankets (small)
- Underwear (new) for men, women and children (small/medium)
- Leggings for women and girls
- Socks (new) for men, women and children (small/medium)
- Tennis shoes for men - size 7, 8, 9, women- sizes- 5, 6, 7, and children- all sizes
- Jackets – all sizes (except x-large) and for all genders
- Winter gloves for all; winter scarves
- Laundry detergent and dryer sheets
- One gallon ziploc bags
