

Here is a summary of migrant deaths reported in September: 35 for the month, notably higher than July and August at 25 each.

Recently found individuals grouped by PMI (Post Mortem Interval):

- 7 dead less than a day
- 3 dead less than 1 week
- 1 dead less than 3 weeks
- 5 dead less than 5 weeks
- 7 dead less than 3 months
- 2 dead less than 6-8 months
- 10 dead more than 6-8 months

Total: 35

Updates for previous cases:

- 18 individuals newly identified by name (1305 cases remain unidentified)
- 8 individuals properly plotted on the map thanks to newly uncovered information

The breakdown by PMI shows that about 2/3 of the deaths occurred within three months prior to discovery, no great surprise given the record-breaking heat and lack of rain this summer.

Attached are a map showing the month's deaths and a table with monthly and yearly statistics for the last 15 years. For the calendar year to date, the total of 181 deaths is more than the whole of any of the last six years.
